

Adobe® Presenter 6.1 Release Notes

Adobe Presenter 6.1 is a Microsoft PowerPoint COM add-in by Adobe that converts PowerPoint presentations into interactive multimedia presentations and eLearning courses. This file contains latest product information, updates, known issues and some tips. Please note that the listing is not exhaustive.

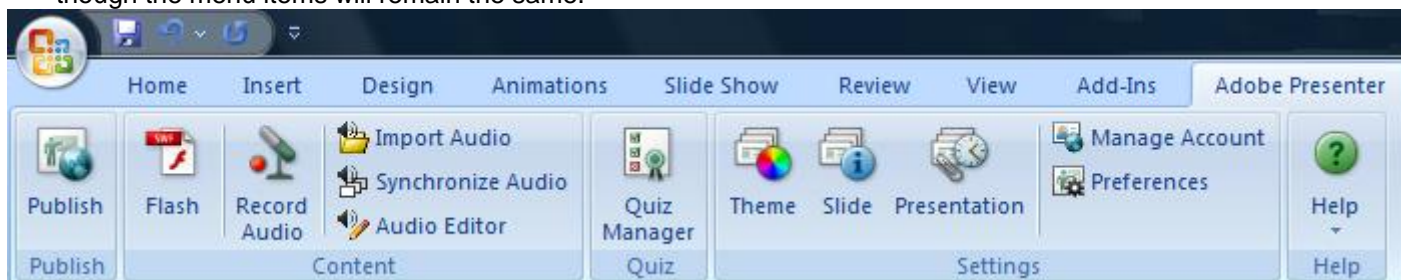

1. System Requirements

- Intel Pentium® III or higher.
- Microsoft XML Library - MSXML 4. If this component is missing on the system, one can download it from <http://www.microsoft.com/downloads>
- Microsoft Windows 2000 SP4/ Windows XP SP2/ Windows Vista
- Microsoft Office PowerPoint 2000/2002/2003/2007.
- At least 128 MB of RAM (256 MB recommended).
- At least 100 MB of free space to install.
- Internet Explorer 6.0 or later.
- For viewing content, browsers supported include Internet Explorer 5.5, 6.0, 7.0, Netscape Navigator 7.2, FireFox 1.5.x, 2.0.x, Safari 1.1, 1.2 and 2.0.x
- Flash Player 7.0 or higher.

2. Product Updates

- Installing Adobe Presenter 6.1 will uninstall the earlier Breeze Presenter 5.1 or Adobe Presenter 6. This does not mean that the earlier settings of Presenters and themes will be lost, but instead will be copied to a new location for use in the current Adobe Presenter.
- Installing Adobe Presenter 6.1 will install Flash Player 9.
- With the release of Adobe Presenter 6.1, support is now extended to **Microsoft PowerPoint 2007** the latest from MS Office. The user will also see the **new Adobe Presenter Ribbon** in PowerPoint 2007 which is different from the simple dropdown menu he would see in Office 2000/2002/2003 though the menu items will remain the same.



- In PowerPoint 2007 a user would have to save the PowerPoint file (.pptx) in **.ppt** format (PowerPoint 97-2003 Presentation) to use and publish from Presenter.

- A user can publish only .ppt files to the Acrobat Connect Enterprise server. Microsoft PowerPoint 2007 file .pptx format files will not be supported for uploading.
- Adobe Presenter > Quiz Manager > Reporting tab now disallows all granular tracking options when 'Adobe Connect Enterprise' is selected as your Learning Management System (LMS). This change is to reflect the functionality of Adobe Connect Enterprise as an LMS, which is to receive data in a specific format. For example, the Connect server always expects Score in a raw score format (rather than a percentage), and the Connect 'Reporting level' will always expect the report to include both interactions and the score.
- Adobe Presenter 6.1 support is also extended to the following flavors of Microsoft Windows **Vista** - Ultimate, Enterprise, Home, and Business.
- Issue with Anti-Virus software has been fixed as Presenter is now a COM add-in.
- The Quiz Manager, Theme Editor, and Audio Editor windows can be resized.
- Audio Recorded using any of the Presenter options will be compressed by default. There is no way a user can change this default behavior.
- Sorensen squeeze FLV's used THV (Talking Head Video) issues fixed in this release.

3. Known issues/Tips/Workarounds

- Uninstalling Adobe Presenter 6.1 will not uninstall Flash Player 9.
- On Win 2k installing Adobe Presenter 6.1 may invoke a Restart message. This happens if Flash Player 9 was previously installed on the system. Pressing either yes or no, on the dialog box will continue with the Presenter installation and on completion no restart is required.
- As a general rule of the thumb, all features of PowerPoint 2007 which are lost when imported to PowerPoint 2003 will not be published. For complete details visit [Office 2007](#) issues page.
- For rearranging question slides within a quiz use the PowerPoint slide view. The change will reflect in the Quiz manager.
- **"Security Warning"** message bar may be displayed below the Ribbon UI in case if we insert flash files in the presentation. In that case you simply need to click on "options" button there and select "Enable content" in Microsoft Office Security Options dialog. Else please check the ActiveX and Macro settings in the Office trust center. Go to Office button -> PowerPoint options -> Trust Center -> Trust center settings -> ActiveX settings and select "Prompt me before enabling all controls with minimal restrictions" radio button. Go to Office button -> PowerPoint options -> Trust Center -> Trust center settings -> Macro Settings and select "Disable all macros with notification" radio button. Now reopen the file, you should be able to see the security warning and select "Enable content
- A user should not move questions from one Quiz to another in Adobe Presenter 6.1. This is not permitted from within Quiz Manager or within the slide views in PowerPoint.
- Presenter 6.1 upgrade from Presenter 6.0 is not supported on Windows Vista. If you want to install Presenter 6.1 on Windows Vista, Please ensure that previous Presenter 6.0 release is uninstalled on that system
- The Presenter 6.1 installer packages Flash Player 9.0.45.0. Installation of Flash Player 9.0.45.0 may fail if earlier version of Flash Player 9.0.16.0 (released in Oct 2006) is already installed. For proper upgradation of Flash Player uninstall the earlier version of Flash Player.
- Double byte path names will not be supported for installing Adobe Presenter, viewing and publishing contents.
- Password protected ppt files will not be supported on Adobe presenter
